SpawGlass celebrates topping out of ACC Rio Grande Campus garage

Austin, Texas – SpawGlass and Austin Community College District are celebrating the topping out of the ACC Rio Grande Campus Parking Garage. The construction milestone will be celebrated Wednesday, May 27, with a barbeque lunch beginning at 11:30 a.m. for all involved with the project.

The new 161,000-square-foot, seven-level parking garage located at 824 West 12th Street will provide more than 600 new parking spaces for students and faculty at the ACC Rio Grande Campus. The ground floor also will include a 2,896-square-foot bookstore. The project is scheduled for completion by early August. Barnes Gromatzky Kosarek Architects designed the building to complement the existing campus and surrounding neighborhood.

A “topping out” is a celebration of the successful and safe completion of the main structure. A tree is traditionally placed on top of the structure as a symbol of this accomplishment.
