SpawGlass awarded Texas A&M University-Commerce student housing project

Houston, Texas – SpawGlass has been awarded the new Texas A&M University-Commerce student housing project in Commerce, Texas by the Texas A&M University System. Existing residence halls will be demolished to make room for the new three-story, wood-framed student housing complex, which will consist of approximately 250 beds, an activity room, study/lounge areas, a computer room and a laundry facility. Construction cost is estimated at \$10,500,000.

SpawGlass teamed with architect BOKA Powell, LLC. to win this project through a design/build process. Design is underway, and construction is scheduled to begin in September 2010.

“This project is an opportunity for SpawGlass to expand our valued relationship with the Texas A&M University System,” said John English, president of SpawGlass’s Senior Living and Campus Housing Division. “Our core value is being number one in client satisfaction, and we have proven that through repeat work with the Texas A&M University System.”
